

# Over \$6.5M invested since 2017



Capacity: \$1.12M in 2021 to 9 preschools to reach more families within existing spaces.



Teacher Training & Retention: 10 educators earning their master's in Jewish ECE at AJU. Year-end bonuses provided to all 160 East Bay educators in 2021 and 2022.



Affordability: Emergency preschool scholarships for over 140 East Bay families.



Relationship-Building: Expand PJ Library Parent Connector program & strengthen bonds across Jewish families.






